



Read the Story of How Surge International and Aztec Washer are teaming up to make a difference:

Poway, California -When Aztec Washer Company CFO Dave Welk introduced Aztec’s founder and CEO Henry “Hank” DeGraan to Surge International founder Dave Irby no one could have predicted what would happen - But thousands of children around the world are benefiting from that meeting.

And it all started with one orphanage in Tecate, Mexico, where Aztec has their main production plant, where DeGraan lives and where Surge came to conduct a soccer clinic for the Rancho San Juan Bosco Orphanage.

“Once Welk and DeGraan brought Aztec onboard, well, the results have been nothing short of spectacular”, says Surge CEO Dave Irby. “Hank has personally expanded our small work in Tecate from one orphanage and 40 children to three orphanages and 150 children. He personally makes sure the orphanages have bread and milk each week.” Irby adds, “Hank’s vision and enthusiasm for our Tecate project has led to some major fundraisers for the orphanages.

With much of the world in turmoil Aztec has been backing Surge’s soccer and multipurpose projects in countries, including: Bolivia, Burundi, Kosovo, Mongolia, Peru, Ukraine, and USA.

In order to generate more funds to help children in desperate situations Aztec and Surge are launching their Kones for Kids program (**k4k**) to support soccer programs so that children around the world might gain hope for a better life.

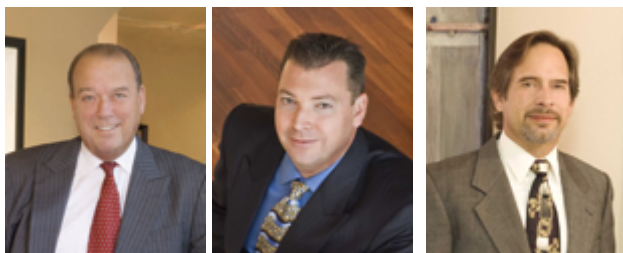
