Trainers in**

**Liberia** - This month we launched a virtual new program to tackle a horrific lingering problem in Liberia. Twenty-four Liberians, double the amount expected, joined Roy and Roberta Reed and key trauma experts from Liberia and the USA for our first training. "According to studies conducted by organizations like the **Harvard Humanitarian Initiative**, **40% of Liberians** suffer from **post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)**, **depression**, and other mental health conditions. These disorders have taken root deeply in the national consciousness, affecting people's ability to heal, rebuild, and move forward." [Sistershospitallers.org](http://Sistershospitallers.org)
